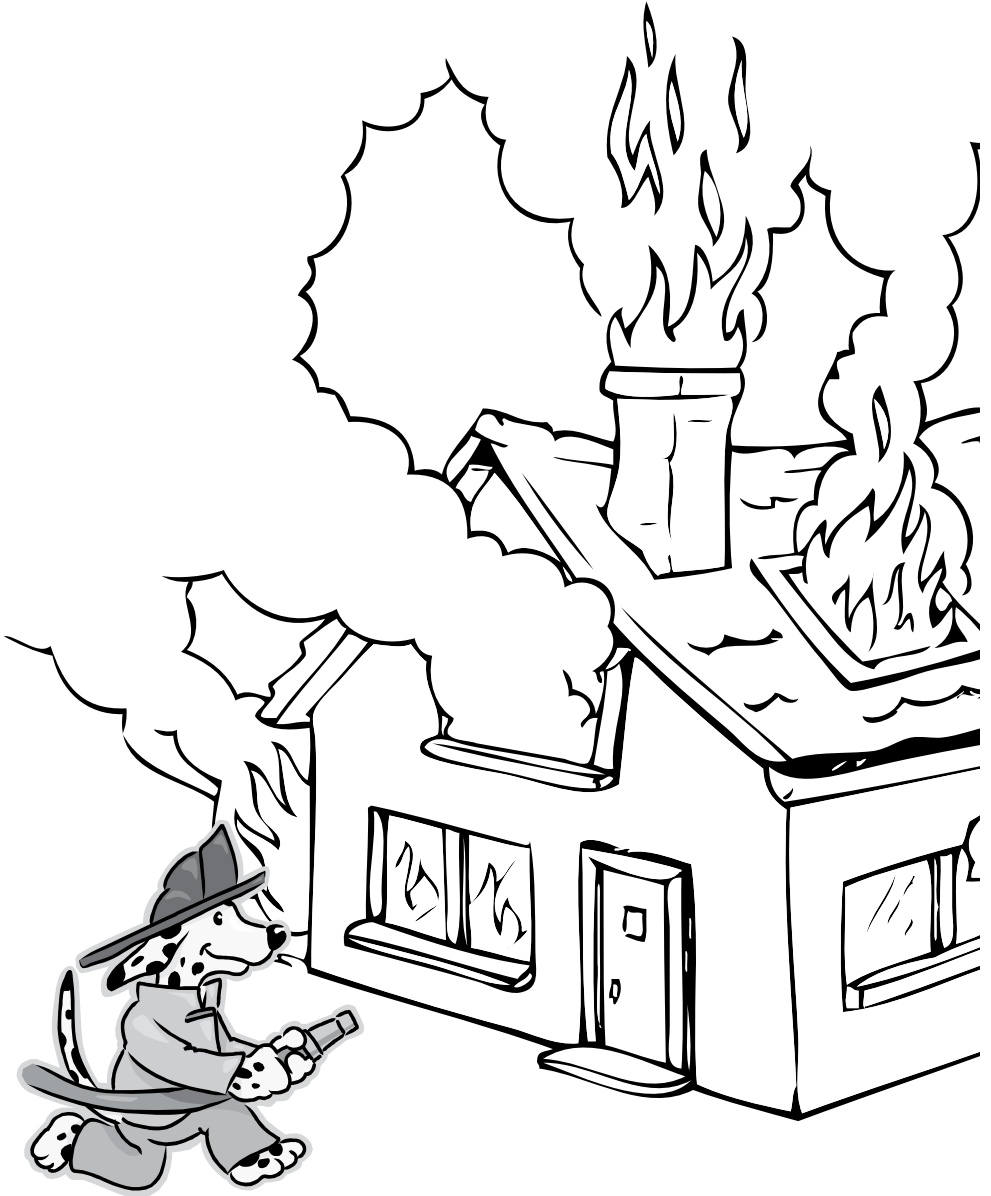

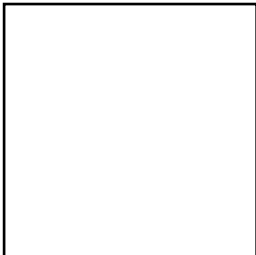

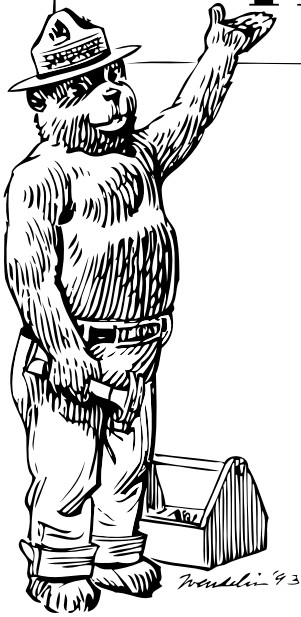

Fire Safety Tips



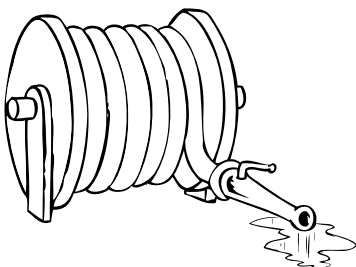
- ✓ Stay away from hot objects
- ✓ Never play with matches, lighters, or candles
- ✓ Have at least one smoke alarm per level in your house
- ✓ Test smoke alarms once a month
- ✓ Change batteries in smoke alarms every six months
- ✓ Create and **Practice** an **Escape Plan** in case of a fire at your house
- ✓ If there is a fire in your house, leave as fast as you can, **do not stop to pick up toys**
- ✓ If there is a fire in your house always test the door to see if it is hot, if it is, **leave through the window**
- ✓ Always crawl under smoke
- ✓ If your clothing or hair catches on fire, **STOP, DROP and ROLL**

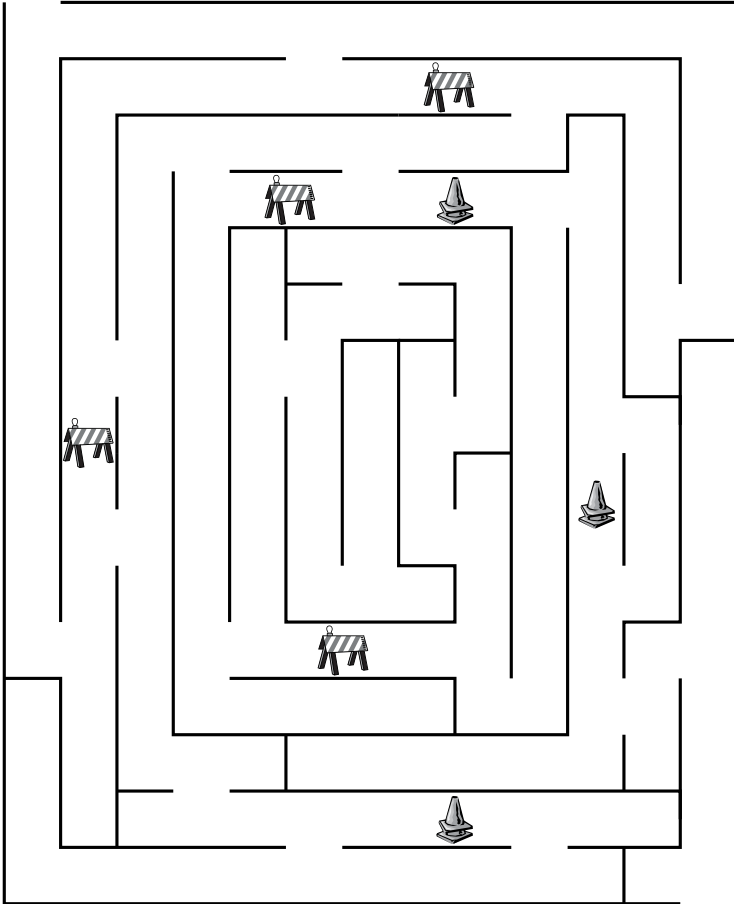

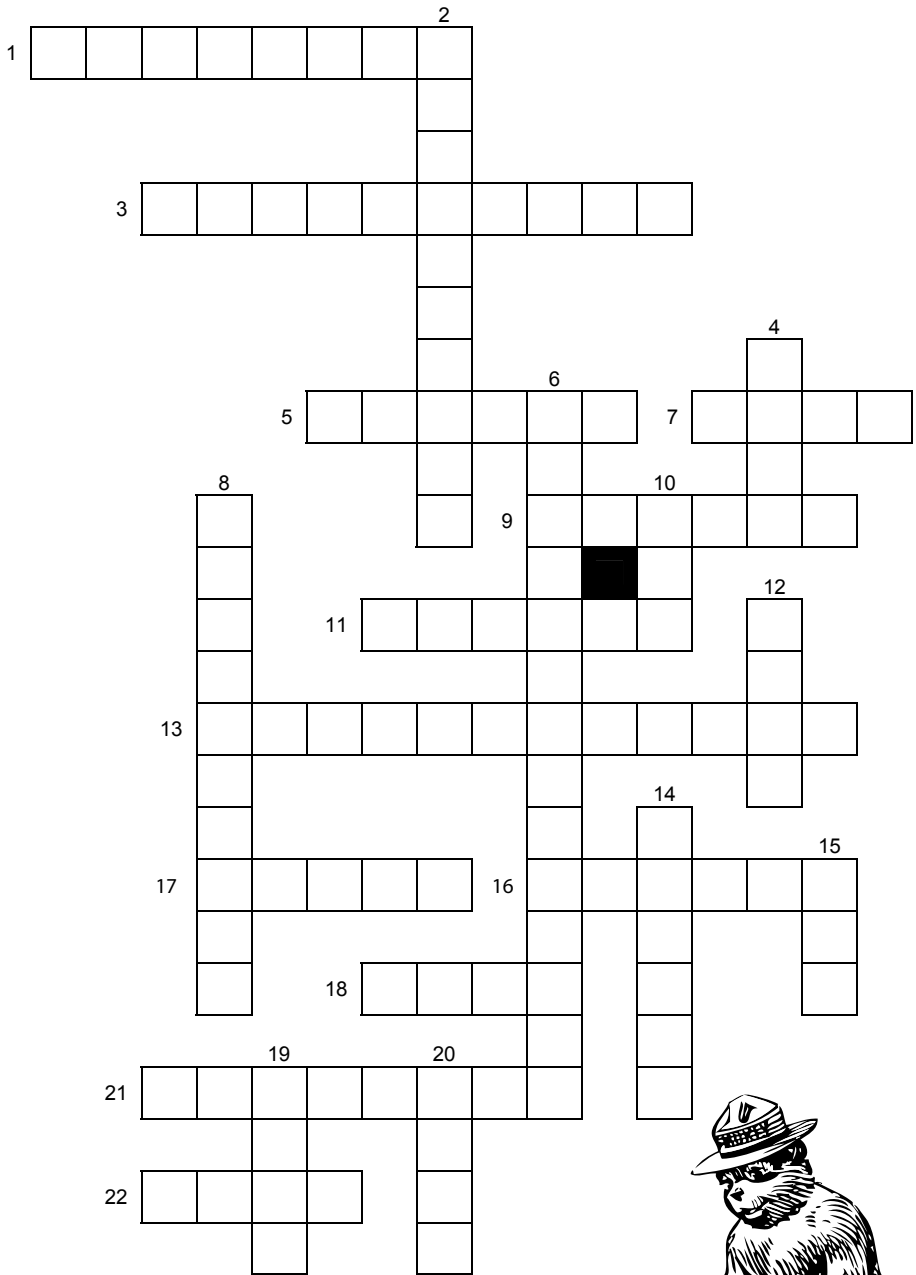

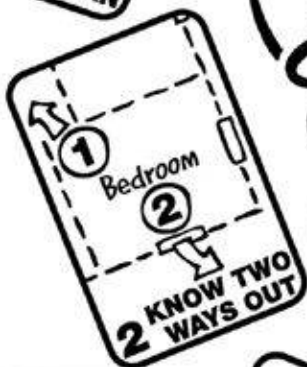

How to Design Your

Fire Escape Plan

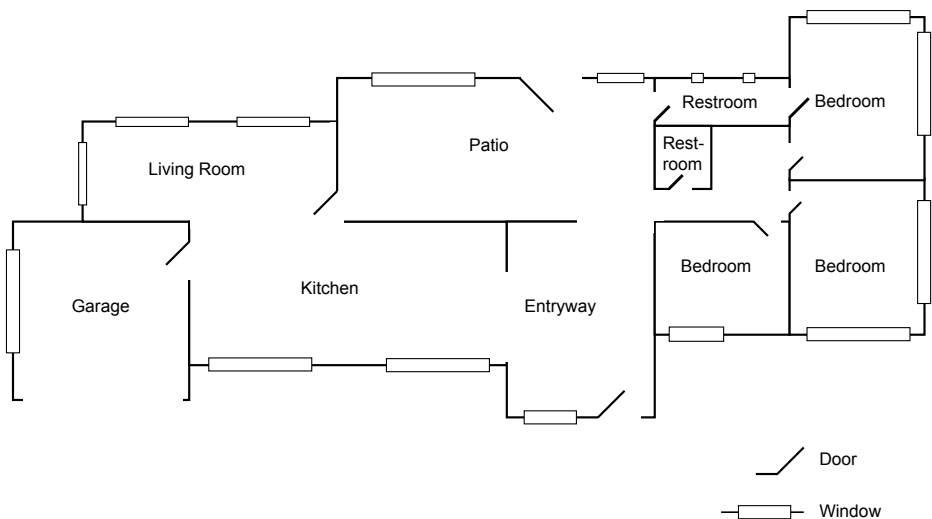
To design your own fire escape plan, sketch the floor plan of your home on a piece of paper. Indicate on the plan all doors, windows and other areas from which you could escape from each room in your home. Draw arrows to indicate the normal exits which would be your primary escape route. With an alternate color, draw arrows to indicate a secondary exit from each room in the home.

Meeting Place

Choose a location outside the home where family members should meet once they have safely escaped. A neighbor's front yard or sidewalk may be an ideal meeting place.

Practice

Circle all of the exits in this home. Then with the color red, draw arrows from each room to show how you can exit the house using doors. Next, using the color blue, draw arrows to show how you can exit the house using windows. Draw a yellow star to show where your meeting place is. Answers on page 20.

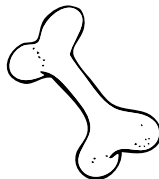
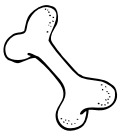
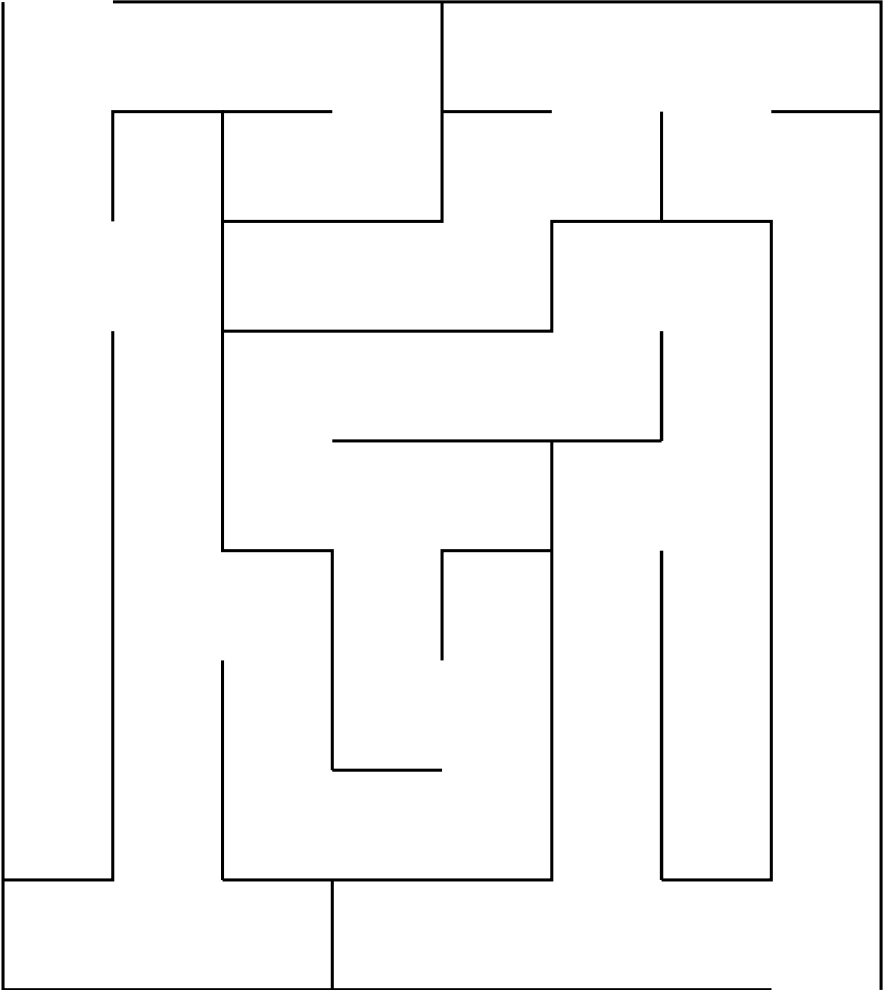

You will need: 1 white square paper, 1 black crayon or marker and an adult to help

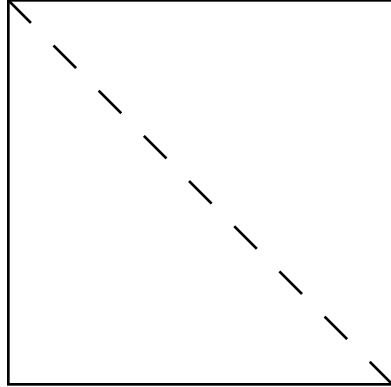
Step 1

Color black spots on your square white paper



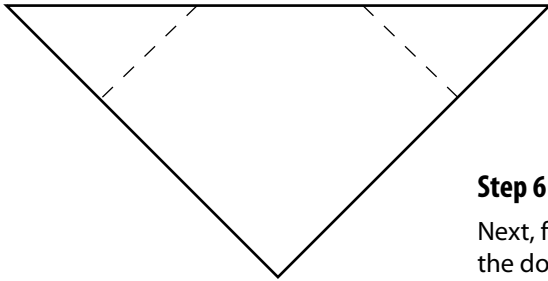
Step 2

Fold your paper in half diagonally, like the dotted line. The spots should be on the outside



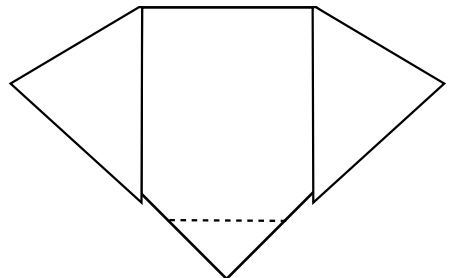
Step 5

Fold the corners of your triangle down, like the dotted lines.



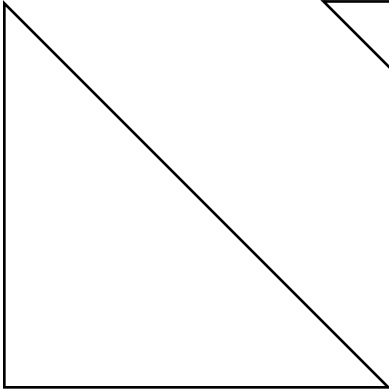
Step 6

Next, fold the bottom corner up, like the dotted line.



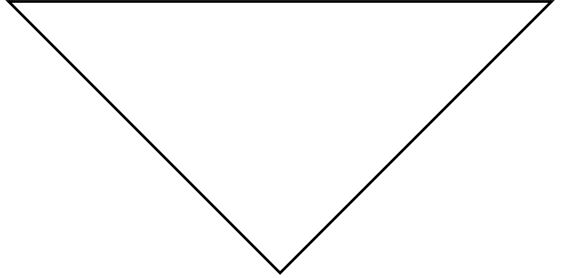
Step 3

You paper should look like this.



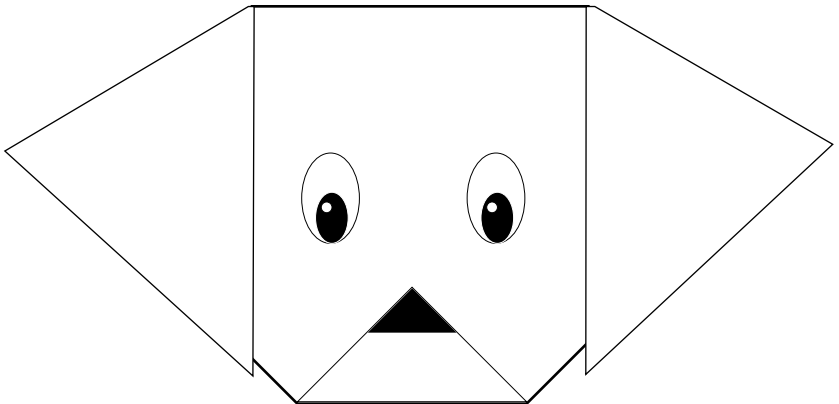
Step 4

Turn your paper so it looks like this.



Step 7

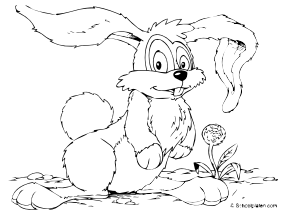
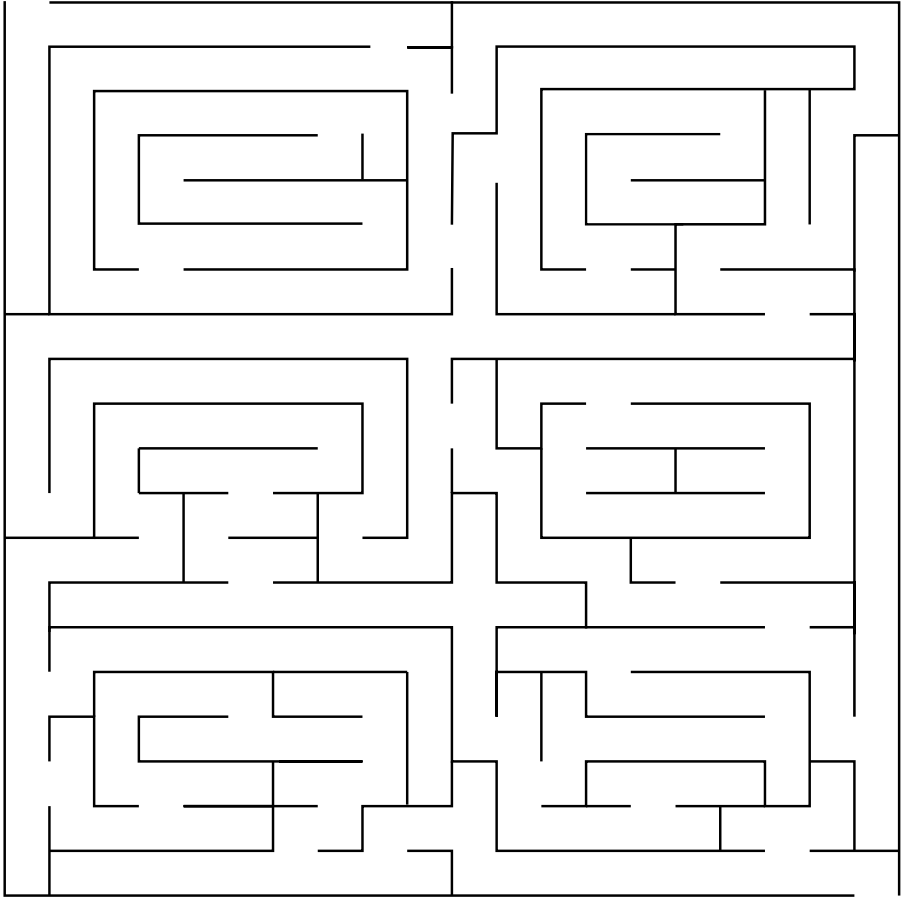
Last, draw Sparky's eyes and nose, and now you're finished!
